Before you start...

To help you get the best out of building the Xenomorph, we've prepared a modellers checklist with hints, tips and advice from our expert. The information below is aimed at making your build as enjoyable and professional as possible right from the start.

Make sure you have good ventilation when using adhesives and to replace caps firmly.

Always use the correct adhesives and always follow manufacturers guidance.

Apply glue sparingly and use a cocktail stick to apply so that you don't use too much nor apply the glue too heavily.

Work in a well lit area. Use an anglepoise lamp or similar on your work bench to ensure you have good light whenever you're at work.

Organise storage – stackable, labeled containers like old clean takeaway or ice-cream plastic tubs with lids are perfect. Small parts which may not be needed until a later stage should be kept in clear plastic and labeled bags.

Use masking tape to hold parts temporarily in place.

Only use the correct size screwdriver that fits the screw head firmly.

Cut parts from a sprue (framework) with side cutters or a craft knife. Side cutters tend to be easiest.

Use a magnet to help find screws that have fallen on the floor.

Leave parts in the paper bags supplied until they are needed. You can write a note of the stage and part on the paper bag too.

If a screw is tight, try turning a half turn forwards followed by a quarter turn backwards. Also, it can sometimes help to temporarily fit a screw into its hole before assembling the parts.

But most of all, enjoy your build!



WARNING: Some parts are assembled using magnets. These magnets can cause serious injury if they are swallowed. Keep away from children. If you suspect a magnet has been swallowed, seek medical help straight away.

All parts belong to a kit. Collectors item for adults.

Not suitable for children under 14.

Some parts may have sharp edges, please handle them with care.

The installation of electronic parts must always be carried out by an adult. When replacing batteries, use the same type of batteries.

Please ensure that the battery compartment is securely fastened before you use the model.

Used batteries should be recycled.

Please make sure to check with your local authority how batteries should be disposed of in your area.

Batteries can present a choking danger to small children and may cause serious harm if ingested. Do not leave them lying around and keep any spare batteries locked away at all times.


In this stage you will continue to build the left hand.

STAGE 53: THE LEFT HAND (II)

Glue six magnets **53-7** into the circular recesses inside the Left Radius Skin **53-1**. It doesn't matter which way round the magnets are fitted.

STAGE 53: THE LEFT HAND (II)




After checking the fit of Left Finger L5 **53-4** on the back of the Left Hand **53-2**, glue in place.



Repeat the previous step to add Fingers L4 **53-3** and L6 **53-5**. As before, glue in place.

STAGE 53: THE LEFT HAND (II)

Take the Left Hand **52-1** which was assembled in pack 7 - stage 52. Fit the free side of the Connector **52-5** over the raised screw socket on the back of Hand **53-2** and fix in place with a 2.3x6mm screw **53-8**. Whilst doing this, it may help to temporarily loosen the previously fitted screw.

! Keep the screws and connector in a safe place until they are needed in the next stage.

STAGE 54: THE LEFT HAND (III)

In this stage you will continue to work on the left hand and left radius.





Take the left radius skin **53-1** from the previous stage. After test-fitting, glue Pipes A2 **54-6** and A1 **54-5** into the slots at the side, as shown. Note the locating peg at one end of each of the Pipes.



Turn the skin **53-1** over and fit the Left Radius **54-1** inside.

Fit six Magnets **54-8** into the circular recesses on the inside of the Left Radius **54-1**. Before glueing in place, make sure that they are correctly orientated so that they are attracted to the corresponding magnets in the skin **53-1** below.

STAGE 54: THE LEFT HAND (III)

Insert the Pin **54-7** into the central hole in the Wrist Joint **54-3**.




Take the left hand assembly from the previous stage and fit the Wrist Joint **54-3** into the slot in the hand formed by parts **52-1** and **53-2**. The ends of the Pin **54-7** should rest in recesses on the hand parts **52-1** and **53-2**. Orientate the Bracket **54-4**, as shown and fit the screw holes over the raised screw sockets on parts **52-1** and **52-3**. When sure of a good fit, secure in place with two 2.3x6mm screws **54-9**.





STAGE 54: THE LEFT HAND (III)

The connector **53-6**, supplied with the previous stage, is fitted across parts **52-1** and **53-2**, as shown. Using two of the 2.3x6mm screws **53-8**, again supplied with the previous stage, fix the connector **53-6** in place.

Test-fit the pegs on the underside of the Left-hand Palm **54-2** into the remaining holes in the hand assembly **52-1/53-2**. When certain of a good fit, glue in place.

STAGE 55: THE LEFT RADIUS


In this stage you will continue to build the left radius and its appendages.

STAGE 55: THE LEFT RADIUS



Lay the Left Radius Skin **55-1** on the work surface and glue six Magnets **55-7** into the circular recesses, as shown. It doesn't matter which way round the magnets are fitted.

Take the radius assembly **53-1/54-1** from the previous stage and separate the two parts. Put the radius **54-1** to one side, leaving just the skin **53-1**.





Fit the tabs of the Pipe A4 **55-5** into the slots along the outer edge of the skin covering **53-1**. Glue in place once you are happy with the fit.

STAGE 55: THE LEFT RADIUS



4 Repeat the previous step to fit Pipe A3 **55-4** into the remaining slots in the skin **53-1**.




5 Join the two parts of the Radius Protector **55-2** and **55-3** together, as shown. Secure in place using two 2.3x4mm screws **55-8**.

STAGE 56: THE RADIUS AND THE HUMERUS

In this stage you will complete the build of the left radius and start assembling parts of the humerus.



STAGE 56: THE RADIUS AND THE HUMERUS



Take the skin **55-1** from the previous stage and place the Left Radius **56-1** inside it.

Fit six Magnets **56-6** into the circular recesses inside the Radius **56-1**. After checking that the magnets are orientated so that they are attracted to those directly below, glue them in position. Once the glue has set, separate the parts and put the skin **55-1** to one side.



Take the radius **54-1** and the hand assembly which was worked on in stage 54. Sandwich the wrist joint **54-3** between the ends of Radius parts **54-1** and **56-1**. See also the next step.

Secure the radius assembly **54-1/56-1** together with six 2.3x6mm screws **56-7**.


Pipes are now fitted to the Left Humerus Skin **56-2**. Test-fit Pipe A5 **56-3** into the corresponding slots, as shown. Once certain of a good fit, glue in place.

STAGE 56: THE RADIUS AND THE HUMERUS

Repeat the previous step to glue Pipes A6 **56-4** and A7 **56-5** into slots along the length of the Skin **56-2**. Note the position of the locating pegs circled in red.

Turn the Skin **56-2** over and glue four Magnets **56-6** into the circular recesses, as shown. It doesn't matter which way up they are fitted.


STAGE 56 IS COMPLETE



THE RADIUS HAS BEEN ATTACHED TO THE HAND AND WORK HAS BEGUN ON THE LEFT HUMERUS.

STAGE 57: THE LEFT HUMERUS (I)

In this stage you will build the outer skin covering of the left humerus and its appendages.

STAGE 57: THE LEFT HUMERUS (I)



Take the Left Humerus Skin **57-1** and test-fit the tabs on Pipe A8 **57-2** into the slots along the side. When certain of a good fit, glue in place.




Repeat the previous step to glue Pipe A9 **57-3** in place, as shown. It is a continuation of Pipe A8 **57-2**.

STAGE 57: THE LEFT HUMERUS (I)



Turn the Left Humerus Skin **57-1** over and glue eight Magnets **57-5** into the circular recesses inside. It doesn't matter which way up the magnets are fitted. The upper-left inset shows where to place the two magnets not visible in the main image. The lower-right inset shows a general view of the assembly after the magnets have been attached.

Turn the skin assembly **57-1** over and fit the peg on the Humerus Appendage **57-4** into the rectangular slot at the end of the Skin **57-1**. The peg is shaped to ensure that it is fitted the correct way round. After test-fitting, glue in place.

Take the humerus skin **56-2** from stage 56 and fit Humerus **58-1** inside.



EXPERT TIP:

As many of the parts are similar and need to be kept to one side at times, it may help to label each part on the underside. This could be done by writing the part number on a small piece of masking tape.



Fit four Magnets **58-8** into circular recesses inside Humerus **58-1**. After checking that the magnets are attracted to those directly below, glue them in place. Once the glue has set, separate the parts and put Humerus **58-1** to one side.

STAGE 58: THE LEFT HUMERUS (II)

With the humerus skin **56-2** still on the work surface, place the Left Humerus **58-2** inside it sideways, as shown. Fit two Magnets **58-5** into a slot and circular recess inside Humerus **58-2**. After checking that the Magnets **58-5** are attracted to those below, glue them in place.



Throughout the build you may notice that there is a slight difference in colour between the parts supplied and those shown. This is due to differences in lighting and the angle of the parts. This will not affect your build.

Separate the parts and put the skin **56-2** aside.

Take the skin **57-1** from the previous stage and in a similar way to step 3, place the Humerus **58-2** sideways inside it. Fit two Magnets **58-5** into the recesses in Humerus **58-2**, as shown. Check that the Magnets **58-5** are attracted to the corresponding ones in the skin below and when correctly positioned, glue in place.

STAGE 58: THE LEFT HUMERUS (II)

Remove the Humerus **58-2** from the skin **57-1** and put the parts to one side. The inset shows a close-up of the magnets fitted in the previous steps.

Join the two parts of the Humerus Protector **58-3** and **58-4** together with two 2.3x4mm screws **58-6** and keep safely aside until needed in a later stage.




In this stage you will continue working on parts of the Xenomorph's left humerus.



STAGE 59: THE LEFT HUMERUS (III)



Fit the holes in Humerus Protector **59-4** over the raised screw sockets on Humerus Protector **59-3**. Secure in place with two 2.3x4mm screws **59-9**.




One magnet **59-5** should be fitted into the circular recess and another into the slot in the Left Humerus **59-1**. Fit the Humerus **59-1** sideways inside skin **56-2** (inset) and when fitted, check that the magnets are attracted to those directly below. When the magnets are correctly orientated, glue in place.



Remove the skin **56-2** and put to one side.

STAGE 59: THE LEFT HUMERUS (III)

Two further Magnets **59-5** are fitted into circular recesses inside the Left Humerus **59-1**. Fit the Humerus **59-1** sideways into the skin **57-1** as shown in the inset. After checking that the magnets are attracted to those directly below, glue in place.

Separate the parts and put the skin **57-1** aside.

STAGE 59: THE LEFT HUMERUS (III)



Take the forearm and fit a Washer **59-2** over the raised socket at the end of parts **58-2** and **59-1**. Bring parts **58-2** and **59-1** together so that their raised sockets fit into the central hole in Radius **56-1**, as shown. See also the diagram in step 7.

Insert screw 3x2.2mm **59-6** through the hole in the joint from the part **59-1** side and fix in place using the Nut **59-7** on the other side. The nut fits into a hexagonal recess in part **58-2**. Make sure the joint is tight, but still has movement for adjustment.

STAGE 59: THE LEFT HUMERUS (III)



Secure parts **58-2** and **59-1** together using four 2.3x6mm screws **59-8**.

ANOTHER HUMERUS PROTECTOR HAS BEEN ASSEMBLED AND MORE MAGNETS ADDED TO THE HUMERUS. THE HUMERUS ASSEMBLY HAS BEEN ATTACHED TO THE FOREARM.

STAGE 60: THE LEFT ARM (I)


In this stage you will continue building the left arm and the assembly of the skin covering of the left humerus.





STAGE 60: THE LEFT ARM (I)



Take the left arm assembly which was worked on in the previous stage. Carefully open Elbow Skin **60-3** and fit it over the elbow as shown in the diagram; the narrow end fits on the radius **54-1/56-1** and the wider end on the humerus **58-2/59-1**. Carefully fit the four holes in the Elbow Skin **60-3** over the raised screw sockets on the right arm. See also the next step.



The Elbow Skin **60-3** is held in place using four 2x4mm flange screws **60-7**; take care not to over-tighten these screws. Once the screws have been fitted, turn the assembly over and glue the edges of the Elbow Skin **60-3** together as shown in the inset photograph. Hold firmly together until the glue has set.



The two skin parts **53-1** and **55-1** will now be joined together. Apply glue to the contact areas on part **53-1**, as shown in green. Hold the parts together firmly until the glue has set. Do not glue the other edges at this stage.

Locate the six pegs on the inside of the wrist **55-6**. Carefully pull the edges of the wrist **55-6** apart so that it fits around the arm assembly **53-1/55-1**. Test fit the pegs in the corresponding holes (circled in green) and when certain of a good fit, apply a little glue to the pegs to secure in place. The edges of the wrist must remain separated for now (inset).

EXPERT TIP:
You may find it easier to glue and secure one half of the wrist before fixing the other half in place.

Take the wrist **55-6**, which was supplied in stage 55 and locate the six pegs inside. Carefully pull the edges of the skin assembly **53-1/55-1/55-6** and fit it around the arm assembly **54-1/56-1**. Study the diagrams carefully and when correctly positioned, glue the edges of the wrist **55-6** together. Then complete the fitting by joining the edges of parts **53-1** and **55-1** together.

STAGE 60: THE LEFT ARM (I)


Take the humerus part **58-1** which was worked on in stage 58 and place the Bush **60-4** over the central shaft, as shown.

Humerus Joint 1 **60-1** and 2 **60-2** are joined together with two 3x22mm screws **60-5**. These pass through the holes in parts **60-1** and **60-2** and are secured in place with two Nuts **60-6**. The nuts fit into hexagonal recesses in part **60-2**. Do not fully tighten the screws at this stage.

STAGE 60: THE LEFT ARM (I)



Note the position of Humerus Joint **60-1** when fitting the assembly **60-1/60-2** over the Bush **60-4**. Also note that there are slight ridges on Humerus Joint **60-2** which fit into slots in humerus **58-1**. Once in place, the screws **60-5** from the previous step may be fully tightened.
